

## ORAGANO SWEATER

When I met dear Carlo Seenjori Signori in April, I decided to give the name Oragano to my sweater. The funny thing was Carlo started to call me "Hurricane" and also, according to him, this color of Amore yarn has a lot to do with me. So, if I wanted to knit something in this beautiful and bright color, I thought the best name to my pattern was the nickname I was given but in Italian, since this amazing yarn is produced in Italy.

### Material:

7 Borgo de' Pazzi Amore balls - color 140

Circular needle 4.5 mm

2 60 cm cables with 2 stops for each cable

1 80 cm cable

2 purple stitch markers (for cast on)

4 green stitch markers (for cast on)

15 stitch markers (for pattern)

### ABBREVIATIONS

K – knit

P – purl

YO – laçada

KFB – knit 1 on the front loop and on the back loop of the same stitch. See video below.

PFB – purl 1 on the front loop and on the back loop of the same stitch. See video below.

M1R – pick up the bar between the last stitch you knit and the one you're about to knit, bringing the needle from the back to the front then knit into the front of this stitch. See video below.

M1L – pick up the bar between the stitch you knit and the one you're about to knit, bringing the needle from front to back then knit into the back of the stitch. See video below.

PSSO – slip 1 st, knit 1, pass the slipped stitch over the knitted stitch.

PSSO2 – slip 1 st, knit 2 together, pass the slipped stitch over the 2 knitted together stitches.

K2TOG – knit 2 together.

SLIPPED STITCH – slip 1,2,3 .... etc.. stitches as if to purl, ie, slip the number of stitches indicated from one needle to another.

MRC – marker

2/2F – 2/2 front cable – put the first 2 stitches on cable needle on front of piece, knit 2, knit the 2 stitches on the cable needle.

2/2B – 2/2 back cable – put the first 2 stitches on cable needle on back of piece, knit 2, knit the 2 stitches on the cable needle.

2/3F – 2/3 front cable – put the first 2 stitches on cable needle on front of piece, knit 3, knit the 2 stitches on the cable needle.

2/3B – 2/3 back cable – put the first 2 stitches on cable needle on back of piece, knit 3, knit the 2 stitches on the cable needle.

## Beginning

Cast on 60 sts.

K1, purple mrc, K1, green mrc, K8, green mrc, K40s, green mrc, K8, green mrc, K1, purple mrc, K1.

### IMPORTANT NOTE:

When you will have 20 sts counting from the 1st st to the 1st purple mrc and another 20 sts counting from last purple mrc to the last st of the row, stop making kfb and pfb and, with right side facing you, cast on 5 sts and insert 1 mrc, that will mark the end of the row. After placing mrc and casting on the new sts, join sts from both needle tips and start knitting in the round.

CONTINUING THE FOLLOWING WAY:

### Section 1

Row 1 – KFB, knit until mrc, slip mrc, knit untill 1 st remain before mrc, M1R, K1, mrc, K1, M1L, K1 untill 1 st remain before mrc, M1R, K1, mrc K1, M1L, K1, knit untill 1 st remain before mrc, M1R, K1, mrc, K1, M1L, knit untill 1 st remain before mrc, M1R, K1, mrc, K1, M1L, knit until last st of the row and knit that st KFB

Row 2 and all even rounds – purl untill you have the above mentioned 20 sts on each side. PFB on 1st and last sts and purl on the remaining sts.

Row 3 - same as 1

## JOIN NECK

When you have 20 cm for armholes (measure from 1st row until the 2 sts that are on the needle, each side of the mrk) and with right side facing you, cast on 5 sts at end of row, place 1 mrc and knit sts that are on the other needle without turning piece.

You will now knit in the round and will divide the sleeves:

## SLEEVES

### Section 1

Place 1 stop on the 60 cm cable to avoid sts to slip off the cable.

With the right side facing you, knit in stockinette st until mrc.

Remove mrc and place on one of the 60 cm cables all sts that are between this cable and the other cable, remove the other cable (insert the other stop on the cable where you just placed sts on hold).

Knit in stockinette st until next mrc.

Place 1 stop at the other 60 cm cable, remove mrc and place the next sts on this cable until the last mrc. Remove mrc and insert the other stop on this 60 cm cable.

Knit in stockinette until the end of round.

### Section 2

Round 1 – separate with 2 mrc back from front. Knit until 1 st before mrc, M1R, mrc, M1L – repeat once more. Knit 10 rounds in stockinette. On 11th round, make increases as explained above. Repeat until you have a total of 264 sts.

### Seção 3

Now, with right side facing you, knit until mrc of beginning of back and:

Round 1 – (P, K2, P4, K9, P4, K2, mrc) X 12

Round 2 – Knit k sts in k and purl sts in p.

Round 3 – (P, K2, P4, YO, PSSO, K5, K2TOG, YO, P4, K2, mrc) x 12

Round 4 – Knit k sts in k and purl sts in p – purl yarn overs.

ROUND WHERE YOU CHANGE MRC FROM PLACE.

Round 5 – P, K2, P5, YO, PSSO, K3, K2TOG, YO, P5, 2/3F, mrc, (P5, YO, PSSO, K3, K2TOG, P5, 2/3F, mrc) X 12 IMPORTANT NOTE: IN ORDER TO MAKE LAST CABLE THE MRK IS DISPLACED ON ROUND.

Round 6 – Same as round 4

Round 7 – 2 slipped sts, mrc, (P4, YO, PSSO, K, K2TOG, YO, P4, 2/2B, P, 2/2F, mrc ) X 12

Round 8 – Same as round 4

Round 9 – 2 slipped sts, mrc, (P3, YO, PSSO, YO, P3, 2/2B, K2, P, K2, 2/2F, mrc ) X 11

Round 10 – (P9, K6, P, K6, mrc ) X 12

Round 11 – 2 slipped sts, mrc, (P5, 2/2B, P2, K2, P, K2, P2, 2/2F ) X 12

Round 12 – Same as round 4

Round 13 – 2 slipped sts, mrc, (P, 2/2B, P2, 2/2B, P, 2/2F, P2, 2/2F, C ) X 12

Round 14 – (P, K2, P4, K2, P5, K2, P4, K2, mrc) X 12

Round 15 – (P, K2, P2, 2/2B, P5, 2/2F, P2, K2 ) X 12

Round 16 – (P, K2, P2, K2, P3, K3, P3, K2, P2, K2, mrc ) X 12

Round 17 – (P, K2, 2/2B, P2, K2TOG, YO, K, YO, PSSO, P2, 2/2F, K2, mrc ) X 12

Round 18 – (P, K5, P4, K5, P4, K5, mrc) X 12

Round 19 – (P, 2/2B, P3, K2TOG, K, YO, K, YO, K, PSSO, K3, 2/2F, ) X 12

Round 20 – (P, K2, P5, K7, P5, K2) X 12

Round 21 – 3 slipped sts, mrc, (P4, K2TOG, K2, YO, K, YO, K2, PSSO, P4, 2/3F, mrc) X 12

Round 22 – (P4, K9, P4, K5, mrc) X 12

Round 23 – (P4, YO, PSSO, K5, K2TOG, YO, P4, K5, mrc) X 12

Round 24 – (P5, K7, P5, K5, mrc ) X 12

Round 25 – (P5, YO, PSSO, K3, K2TOG, YO, P5, 2/3F, mrc) X 12

Round 26 – (P6, K5, P6, K2, P, K2, mrc) X 12

Round 27 – 2 slipped sts, mrc, (P4, YO, PSSO, K, K2TOG, YO, P4, 2/2B, 2/2F, mrc) X 12

Round 28 – (P5, K3, P5, K5, P, K5, mrc) X 12

Round 29 - 2 slipped sts, mrc, (P3, YO, PSSO2, YO, P3, 2/2B, K2, P, K2, 2/2F, mrc) X 12

Round 30 – (P9, K2, P2, K2, P, K2, P2, K2, mrc) X 12

Round 31 – 2 slipped sts, mrc, (P5, 2/2B, P2, K2, P, K2, P2, 2/2F, mrc) X 12

Round 32 – (P5, K2, P4, K2, P, K2, P4, K2, mrc) X 12

Round 33 – 2 slipped sts, mrc (P, 2/2B, P2, 2/2B, P, 2/2F, P2, 2/2F, mrc) X 12

Round 34 – If you don't want a long tunic, you can stop pattern here. (P, K2, P4, K2, P5, K2, P4, K2, mrc) X 12

Round 35 – (P, K2, P2, 2/2B, P2, K, P2, 2/2F, P2, K2, mrc) X 12

Round 36 – (P, K2, P2, K2, P3, K3, P3, K2, P2, K2, mrc) X 12

Round 37 – (P, K2, 2/2B, P2, K2TOG, YO, K, YO, PSSO, P2, 2/2F, K2, mrc) X 12

Round 38 – (P, K5, P4, K5, P4, K5, mrc) X 12

Round 39 – (P, 2/2B, P3, K2TOG, K, YO, K, YO, K, PSSO, P4, 2/2F, mrc) X 12

Round 40 – (P, K2, P5, K7, P5, K2, mrc) X 12

Round 41 – 3 slipped sts, mrc, (P4, K2TOG, K2, YO, K, YO, K2, PSSO, P4, 2/3F, mrc) X 12

Round 42 – (P4, K9, P4, K5, mrc) X 12

Round 43 – (P4, YO, PSSO, K5, K2TOG, YO, P4, K5, mrc) X 12

Round 44 – (P5, K7, P5, K5, mrc) X 12

Round 45 – (P5, YO, PSSO, K3, K2TOG, YO, P5, 2/3F, mrc ) X 12

Round 46 – (P6, 5, P6, K2, P, K2, mrc) X 1

Round 47 – 2 slipped sts, mrc, (P4, YO, PSSO, K, K2TOG, P4, 2/2B, P, 2/2F, mrc) x 12

Round 48 – (P5, K3, P5, K5, P, K5, mrc) x 12

Round 49 – 2 slipped sts, mrc, (P3, YO, PSSO2, YO, P3, 2/2B, K2, P, K2, 2/2F, mrc) x 12

#### Section 4

Remove markers. Knit 17! rib (= 1 k st, 1 p st) and bind off.

#### Section 5

Place stitches on hold on one of the 60 cm cables and with right side facing you:

Pick up 4 sts from armhole, place mrc for beginning of round, K2TOG, K until 2 sts before mrc, 1 PSSO, 10 rounds in stockinette, on 11th round repeat decreases. Repeat until you have the diameter you want for cuff. Then, keep on knitting in stockinette, End with a 1/1 rib and bind off.

Knit the other sleeve the same way.

## Secção 5

Puxar as sts do pescoço fazer canelado 1/1 e rematar.

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
